

Itinerary

DAY 1 • Depart U.S.

Depart for your overnight flight to Dublin, Ireland.

DAY 2 • Dublin, Ireland

Arrive in Dublin, then meet travelers from our *Scottish Highlands and Lowlands: Edinburgh, St. Andrews, National Parks & Glasgow* pre-trip extension.

DAY 3 • Dublin

Enjoy a panoramic tour of Dublin, focusing on landmarks and historic monuments at O'Connell Street. Then, discover St. Stephen's Green during the walking portion of your tour. From here, we'll make our way to the Irish Emigration Museum by motorcoach. The rest of the day will be free to make your own discoveries.

DAY 5 • Belfast • Cider visit • Explore Belfast

Depart for Belfast, the capital of Northern Ireland. Along the way, stop at an apple orchard and meet the owner of a family-owned cidery, and enjoy lunch. Upon arrival in Belfast, you're free to explore the historic city.

DAY 6 • Belfast • Controversial Topic: The Troubles • Taxi tour

Engage in a **Controversial Topic** about the Troubles with three men who once fought on opposite sides of this bloody conflict. Then explore Belfast like a local: in an iconic taxi cab, whose driver will share their view on the city's political and religious divides.

DAY 7 • Belfast • Optional Ards Peninsula & Mount Stewart House and Gardens Tour • Home-Hosted Dinner

Enjoy a day of personal time in Belfast. Or, join a full-day optional tour of The Ards Peninsula in County Down where you'll embark on a guided tour of the Mount Stewart House and Garden, including lunch in the small town of Portaferry. This evening, enjoy an Irish cuisine at a **Home-Hosted Dinner**.

DAY 8 • Belfast • The Antrim Coast • Giant's Causeway

We head east along the Antrim coast, stopping first to view the Carrick-A-Rede Rope Bridge. Roughly 100 feet high and 70 feet long, the bridge connects Carrick-A-Rede Island to mainland Ireland. From here, we'll transfer by coach to visit the Giant's Causeway, an unforgettable landscape formed by volcanic eruptions dating back millions of years.

DAY 9 • Museum of Free Derry • Controversial Topic: Bloody Sunday conversation • Derry • Donegal

Visit the Museum of Free Derry where local volunteer's will talk about the 1972 massacre, "Bloody Sunday," when British soldiers killed 14 unarmed Catholic protesters. Then, explore Derry, and tour the city walls and murals inspired by the Troubles. After breakfast, we'll drive to Derry, also known as Londonderry depending on where you are in Ireland. Divided by the River Foyle, which runs through the city's heart, Derry is one of Europe's last walled cities, and the only one in Ireland whose walls are still fully intact.

DAY 10 • Donegal • A Day in the Life of a Donegal tweed weaver & Killybegs fisherman

Experience A Day in the Life of a Donegal tweed weaver in St. John's Point, then travel to Killybegs to learn about the life of a local fisherman, including a fresh-caught seafood lunch.

DAY 11 • Donegal • Optional Glenveagh National Park tour

Enjoy a free day in Donegal. Or, join us on our optional Glenveagh National Park tour to explore its magnificent gardens.

DAY 12 • Connemara • Drumcliff • National Museum of Ireland Country Life • National Famine Memorial

Head to Connemara, stopping en route in Drumcliff, where poet W.B. Yeats was laid to rest. Then, visit the National Museum of Irish Country Life, followed by a stop at the National Famine Memorial near Croagh Patrick, before checking in to your hotel in Clifden.

DAY 13 • Connemara • Sheep farm • Kylemore Estate & Abbey

Explore Connemara today, beginning with a visit to a sheep farm, where we'll get hands-on shearing experience, enjoy a conversation with a local farmer, and witness a sheep dog demonstration. Then, head to Kylemore Estate and Abbey.

DAY 14 • Ennistymon • Galway • Hazel Mountain Chocolate Workshop

Transfer to Ennistymon in County Clare, stopping along the way in Galway for a walking tour and free time. We'll continue our journey as we drive along the Wild Atlantic Way for Ennistymon, stopping at the Hazel Mountain Chocolate workshop. Later, we'll check into our hotel where the rest of the evening is free.

DAY 15 • Optional Aran Islands Tour • Ennis

Enjoy a free day to explore County Clare. Or, choose our optional Aran Islands tour, boarding a ferry to Inis Oirr, where the island's 250 residents still speak Gaelic and weave Celtic customs into their daily lives.
